Strategies & Challenges in Execution of the Nation's First Ultra Mega Power Project (UMPP) at Mundra

Mr. Alok Kanagat - Executive Director, Coastal Gujarat Power Limited (CGPL) is implementing the 4,000 MW (800 MW x 5 Units) UMPP near the port city of Mundra in the State of Gujarat in India. Mundra UMPP has established India's first 800 MW units based on supercritical technology and is arguably the most energy-efficient, coal-based thermal power plant in the country, today. The project will supply power to 5 States, namely Gujarat and Maharashtra in Western India and Haryana, Rajasthan and Punjab in Northern India, which currently are facing severe shortage of electricity. It will provide a competitive source of power and help meet these states growing demand for electricity. He has explained how Mangroves plantation is carried out in this area. He has highlighted the benefits as India's first 4000 MW private power project near

Mundra Port, Kutch District of Gujarat, India's first 800 MW unit thermal power plant using supercritical technology, Main power generation equipment sourced from Korea and Japan, Creation of 5000 construction jobs and 700 operations oriented jobs, Most energy efficient plant in India with lower Green House Gas (GHS) emissions vis-à-vis existing plants, Once complete, the Mundra project will meet 2% of India's power needs, Consumers in five of India's power starved States will benefit from this project.

This project has won -1) Asia – Pacific Power Deal of the Year awarded by PFI in2008 for its financing achievement in a span of 12 months in power sector. 2) Infrastructure Excellence Award 2012 in the Energy and Power category for the execution of Mundra UMPP.

Technologies Transforming Business and Enabling Sustainable Development

Mr. Nitin Kulkarni - Executive Director and Chief Operating Officer, Persistent Systems, speaking on Technology Trends that are transforming your business. Specially Smart Phones, Cloud Computing these are some of latest trends which are changing the way we work or live today.

Execution of Gujarat Solar Power Project

Mr. P. H. Rana, Project Director, Gujarat Solar Project - provided invaluable insights into their challenges and successes in execution of Gujarat Solar Power Project. He has explained how this project successfully executed in remote place such as Kuchh, Gujarat. He also stressed on the importance of Govt support in executing this unique Solar project in India. One can imagine the scale and complexity of this project by looking at the area which it has

covered, generates 600 MW solar energy, 22+ Indian and Foreign Developers were involved in this project with their respective solar technology. This solar park is already became the Asia's Biggest Solar Part. Most of the work is done by Local Manpower which has reduced the cost of Manpower substantially.

JAL DOOT - A Project of mobile water filtration system for villagers Need of the hour!

Mr. Subhash Devi, Founder of Membrane Filters and Inovent Industries and Innovator of 'Jaldoot'. A Project of mobile water filtration system for villagers – Need of the hour. Most of villagers in India do not have drinking water facility. Many of them need to go to Lake, Wells to get the water. Water in these is highly contaminated and not useful for drinking purpose. Therefore Subhash Devi has come with an Idea 'Jaldoot'. The unique feature of 'Jaldoot' is that the way Milkwala goes house to house to supply the Milk; similarly 'Jaldoot' supplies the water by going house to house. Membrane Filter which set on the Vehicle ensures the Filtered Water is supplied to the families. He has successfully done this by setting 15+ vehicles in a Village near Pune with the help of Local NGO. He has also explained the Benefits of Membrane Filters over the UV Filters.
