### 108<sup>th</sup> MONTHLY SEMINAR!

PMI Pune Deccan-India Chapter organized its 108th Monthly Seminar on Oct 12th 2013. This seminar was attended for over 105 members / non-members. Seminar was conducted in two sessions.

#### Session 1-

##### 'Why you did not get that promotion'

###### Speaker Profile-

Vishwanath Joshi, 36 years, is a Post Graduate in Human Resource Management from Pune University. Spanning his career of more than 12 years, he has worked with IT consulting organizations like Mahindra Consulting, Patni, KPIT Cummins Infosystems Ltd and Brainvisa Technologies, Pune. He was also an Advisor – Training and HR with Decos Software Development, Pune for more than 4 years.

Often, executives in organizations are frustrated when their efforts are not rewarded as per their expectations. With limited budgets and career paths available in modern organizations, this challenge has become more acute. In Speaker's experience working with thousands of mid-level executives across dozens of organizations, he came across some interesting patterns on how they feel about missing such growth opportunities and how they cope with these 'losses'.

In this seminar, he presented some of his observations and learnings along with some research based insights on decoding some unwritten rules of corporate advancements and ways to take more ownership for self-growth and development. The discussion started with a list of typical feedback that is received during appraisal and meaning of that feedback. He then discussed the non-negotiable key factors that are essential for promotion. He then talked about the factors that prompt the de-selection from the promotion candidates list. He then elaborated on key factors for "executive career" and level 5 leader characteristics. He concluded with a list of action items for improving the chances of promotion. The session was interactive.

Girish Kelkar or GSK as he is popularly known, has had a varied and experienced career ranging from Managing Director Satt Control India Ltd. Involved in Strategic Planning & Business Development for the Organization to Senior Advisor in Power Exchange India Limited as Head of IT involved in development of novel applications and overall Management of IT function.

For achieving the expected business results, one must think strategically and then take decisions strategically. Most of the mission critical projects/programs/portfolio scenario needs the business leaders think and take decisions strategically for achieving a win-win proposition for themselves and their customers. The session intended to highlight various business scenarios requiring attention strategically and then the decision taken that drives the entire delivery process and customer engagements very productive.

The session intended to discuss some sample hypothetical scenarios with attendees and engage them to brainstorm for thinking strategically and take decisions to demonstrate the

value of the strategic thinking and decision making. He started with the definitions of vision, mission, goal, strategy and tactics. Then he discussed about importance of thinking and ability to think along with characteristics of critical thinking. He also elaborated on deductive thinking and inductive thinking during the question and answer session. He used events during Chhatrapati Shivaji's reign as examples to support his discussion.

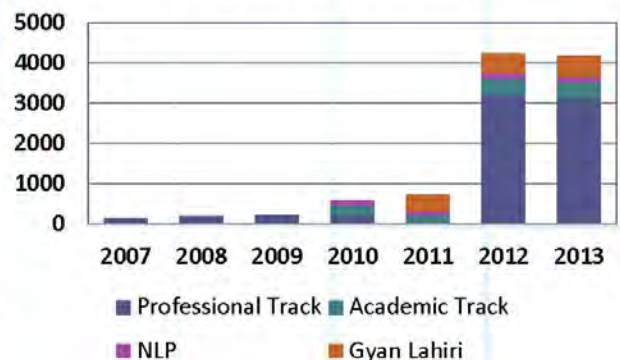

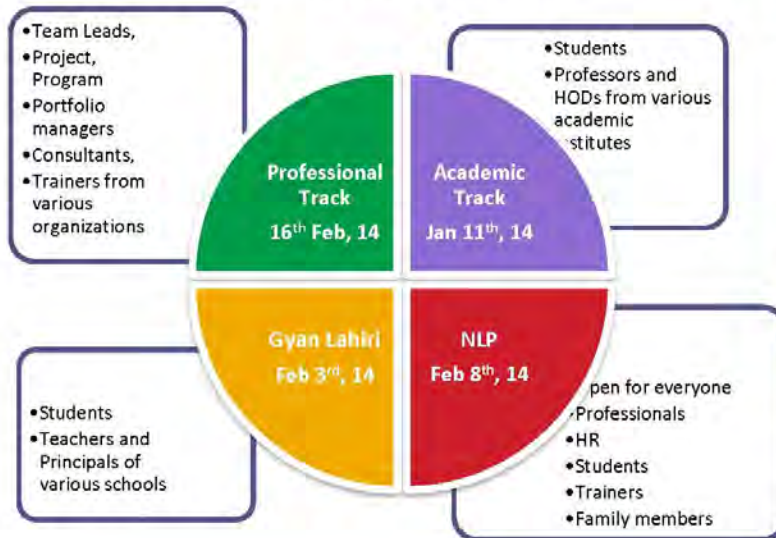
